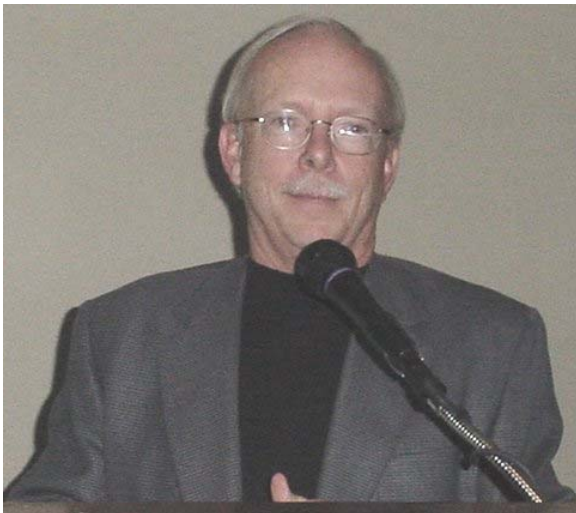
This week

It is all set up for next Friday — in place of the regular Friday meeting. Be sure to make sure you have signed up and then make sure

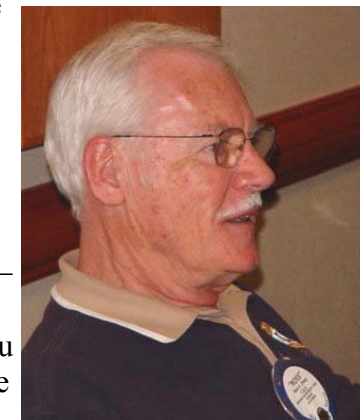
