Janet Sederquist will be here to tell us what the Oxnard Convention and Visitor's Bureau does, and where it is going.

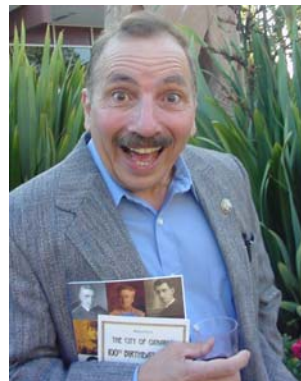
Last week
