## Ramblings from Ross



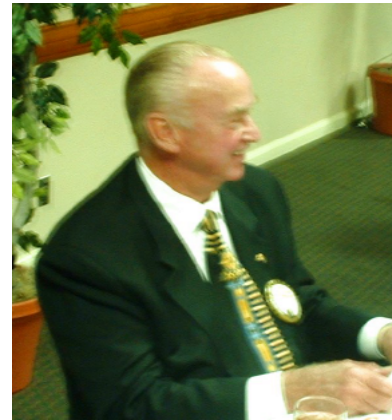
