Will Berg is sending me the times of the event and where our booth will be located.

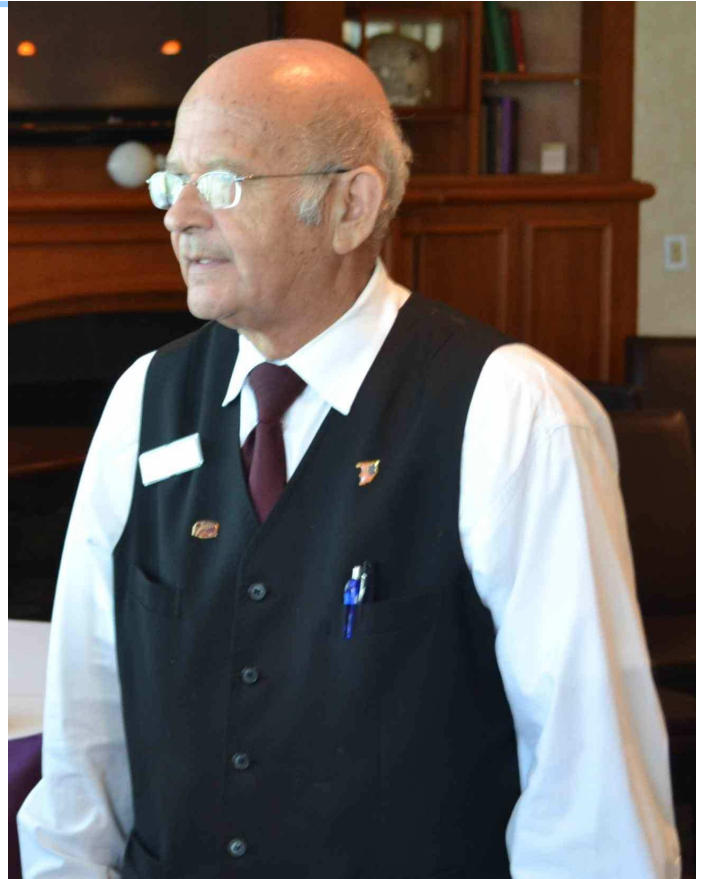
We will need to make 2 teams, probably from 10 to 2 for one team and from 1 to 4 for the other team to man the booth. Exact time forthcoming.
