## [Last Week](#)

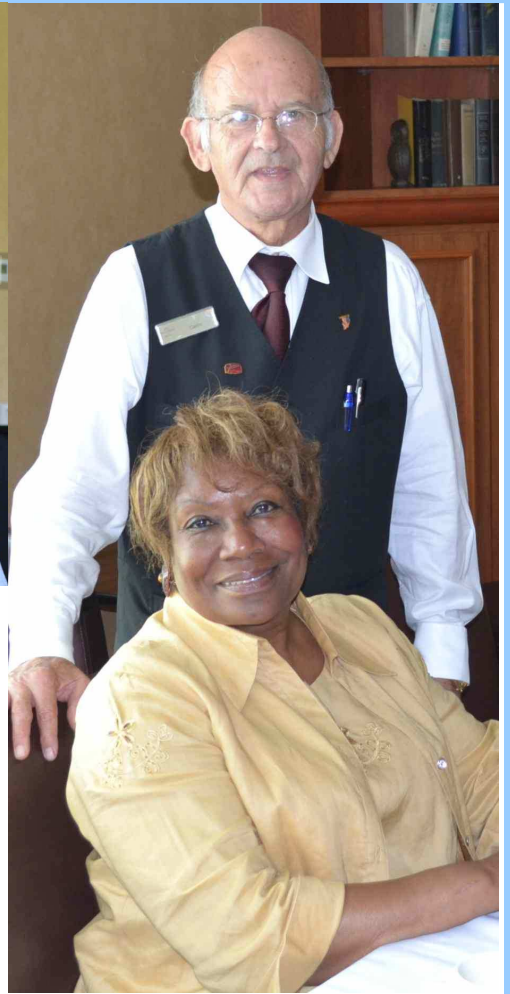
