Nancy Lewis from City of Hope dropped by to pick up a check from us for \$1,600 and to tell us about all the wonderful things they are doing. One huge advantage they have over other cancer research centers is they can manufacture their own trial drugs. Other centers have



to sell pharmaceutical companies on the potential of the drug and are dependent on others for approval to start clinical trials. City of Hope has cut the average time for getting drugs out of clinical trials and into the market from 27 years to 7. And because they manufacture the clinical trial drugs, they collect a much fatter royalty payment when they do sell the product to the eventual manufacturer. They use this for more research. Lions have partnered with City of Hope for 50+ years. City of Hope holds a Lions Appreciation Day usually on the last Sunday in March. It is a fantastic experience — one all Lions should avail themselves of at least once.
