He compared cost per BTU amongst the contenders and indicated that there is going to be very little new drilling in expensive places like the arctic because of the reduction in crude oil prices. Until oil goes back up, they just aren't economically viable. Same for oil shale and tar sands, which are expensive to extract. Meanwhile the efficiency and cost for solar has been declining so it is now fairly competitive — at least in large, commercial applications. Excellent speech.
