

Last Week's Meeting

Fraudulent fire inspections conducted by the notorious Orco Fire Protection Company was one of the topics discussed at last week's meeting. Oxnard Fire Department Investigator Tiloi Tuitama presented the scheme and reported many local small and large businesses have fallen prey to it. Orco Fire Protection Company and others fall under the umbrella of Dan Weavers. He warned that the "inspectors" go to businesses and then bill for services, anywhere from a few hundred to several thousands of dollars. He stated that these companies are operating throughout the western United States.
