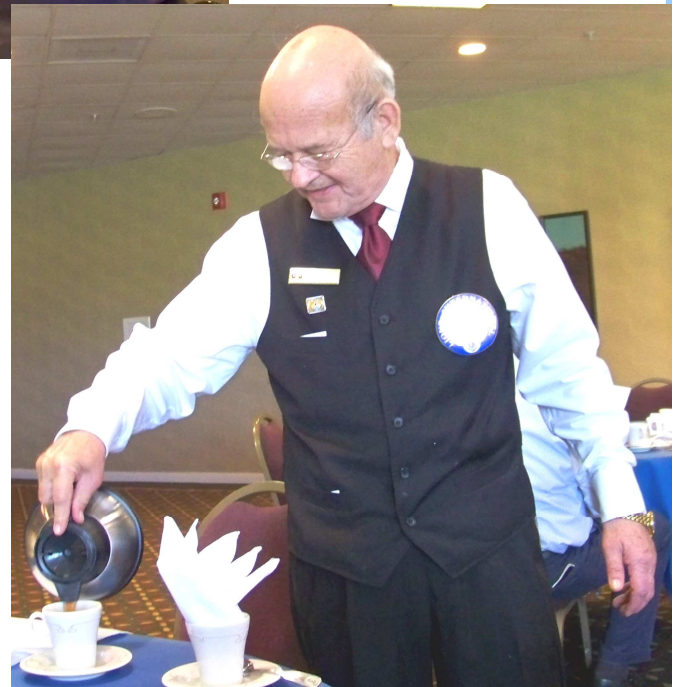


To get there, take 126 into Fillmore, turn left on Mountain View and then right on Sespe to the end on the right.
