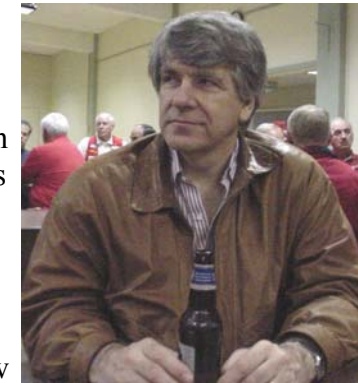
Pleasant Valley Visitation
