Since it is the last Friday of the month, presumably it is open. But who knows?

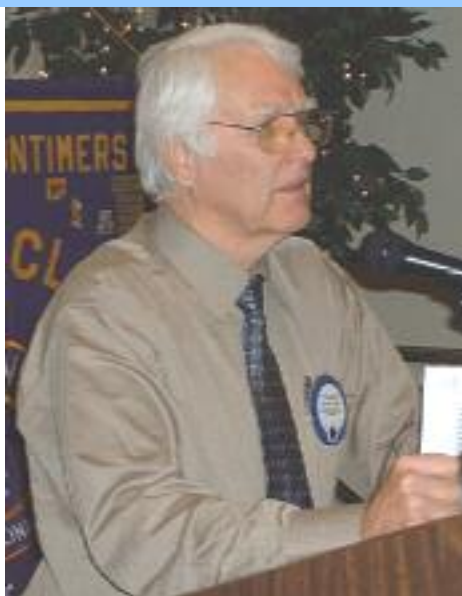
