This week

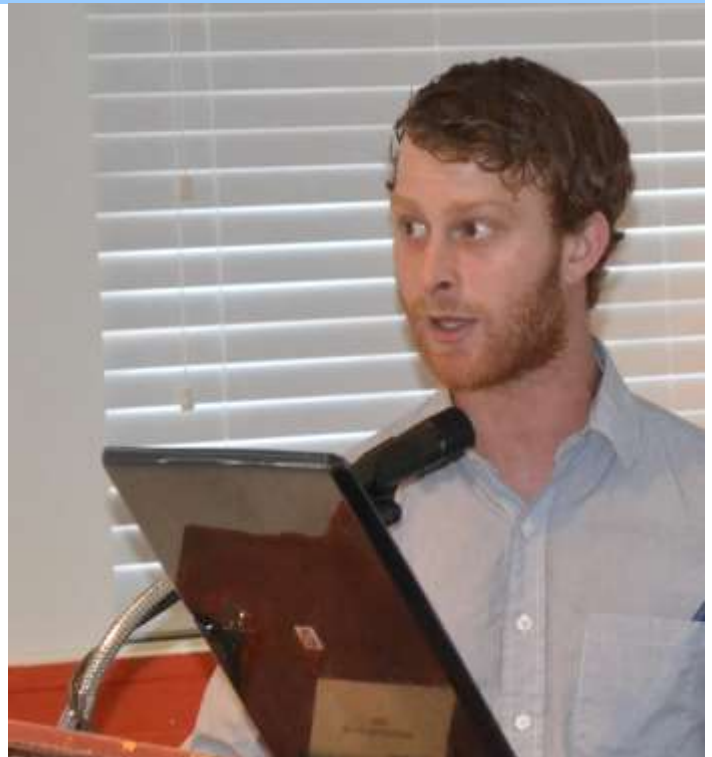
