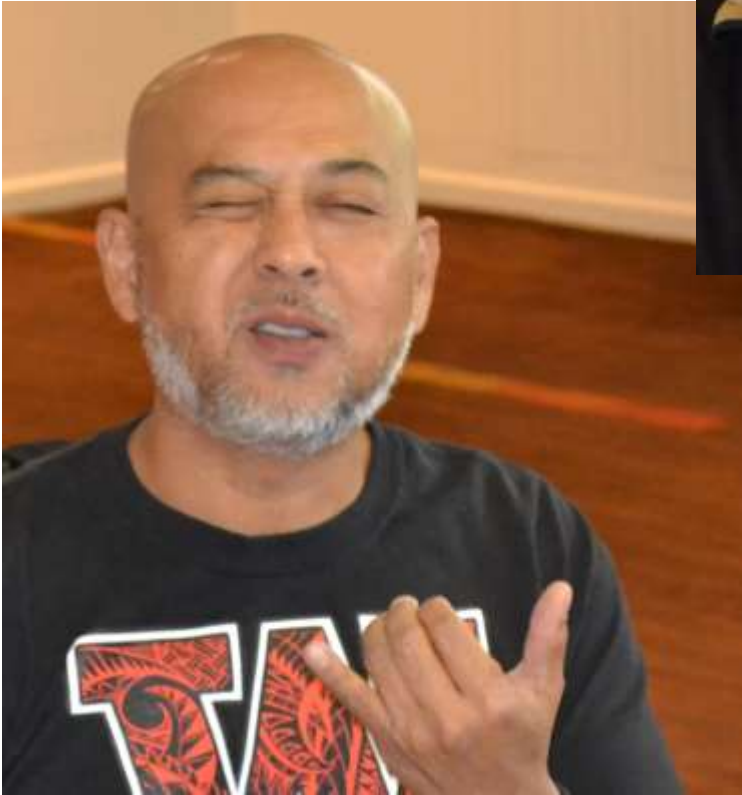
Winners
